Each year, United Way of Eastern Utah recognizes students who have volunteered to make the most of these opportunities. We are pleased to offer up to 6 one-time scholarships to high school seniors residing in our service area:

Daggett, Duchesne, Uintah, Carbon, Emery, Grand, and San Juan Counties

These scholarships are available to students who have committed to volunteering and improving their community <u>and</u> who enroll in trade school, university, or other approved educational endeavor for Fall 2023.

Examples of trades include cosmetology, plumbing, welding, truck driving, etc.

Eligibility

Applicants must participate in meaningful service projects/service opportunities before April 8, 2023. This service is in honor of our annual Day of Caring. These projects/opportunities can include but are not exclusive to:

Martin Luther King, Jr. Service Day, United Way of Eastern Utah Angel Tree Program, United Way Day of Caring, The People's Garden at Carbon County Food Bank, Emery County Food Bank, USU SUN Center, Green River Epicenter, Green River Community Center, Boys and Girls Club of Carbon County, Southeastern Utah Head Start, or any qualifying service project approved by United Way of Eastern Utah.

Volunteer Verification Form

A volunteer verification form is included (see below; please make copies as needed). This form is a required part of the scholarship application and must be filled out and signed by the person overseeing the program or project you are volunteering for.

The deadline for applications is **April 14, 2023**. Only complete applications with supporting documents will be accepted. If the committee deems it necessary, an interview will be held as part of the application process.

 - b. How do you plan to contribute to your community in the future?
- 3. A resume of **high school** involvement that includes the following, if applicable:
 - volunteer activities
- work experience
- extra-curricular activities
- honors/awards received
